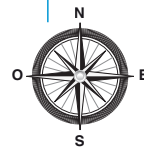

CONTROL CODES

1	Plaça de Catalunya (railing, bridge). One of the city's most emblematic squares, from where you can also see the popular Pont de Pedra bridge, built in 1856.
2	Peixateries Velles bridge (railing, bridge). Also known as the Eiffel bridge, as it was designed by the same engineer and architect as the famous tower in Paris.
3	Passeig de Canalejas (traffic sign). This point offers one of the best views of the colourful houses over the River Onyar.
4	Carrer de la Barca (building, corner). Known as the Sant Pere district due to its proximity to Sant Pere de Galligants, for many years this area was the city's red-light district.
5	Plaça de la Catedral (building, corner). Flanked by a dramatic staircase, the cathedral is the result of various superimposed styles, from Romanesque to neoclassical.
6	Carrer de la Força (singular tree). The main artery for exploring the Jewish Quarter and part of the former Via Augusta, in Roman times it was also Girona's cardo maximus, or main street, which crossed from one city gate to another.
7	Plaça dels Mercaders (between two trees). This area is home to many of medieval Girona's typical streets, where craftsmen and women would set up shop in streets that still bear the names of their trades.
8	Alferes Huarte bridge (railing, bridge). Bridge over the River Onyar, which rises up in the Guilleries mountains and joins the River Ter after crossing the historic centre of Girona.
9	Lion monument (railing, corner). Built on the base of the former Sant Francesc bastion, this popular monument topped by a lion stands beside the municipal market.
10	Former Santa Caterina Hospital (building, corner). Currently the headquarters of the Catalan Autonomous Government in Girona, this building with its Baroque facade includes the unique Magnòlies courtyard and one of the country's most important historic pharmacies.
